Church Board of the United Church of Christ in Medfield

Using the congregations' expressed identity (core values, beliefs, vision statement), the church board will define broad policies related to general direction and purpose of ministry. It will evaluate initiatives, programs, and activities of the church to determine whether they fall within the boundaries of that identity and meet an acceptable level of risk. The church board also measures the success of the impact on the community and the world in pursuit of their congregational mission.

Persons interested in serving on the church board should:

- Be an active member of the church
- Be committed to the church vision and mission
- Possess the spiritual gifts for this position including:
 - Leadership qualities
 - Receptive to new or other peoples' ideas
 - Comfortable with conflict
 - Willing to make decisions when presented with information
- Have an authentic call
- Are currently participating or have previously participated in church ministry
- Demonstrate financial support of the church
- Committed to living the Six Marks of Discipleship
- Willing to make a three year commitment and attend meetings regularly
